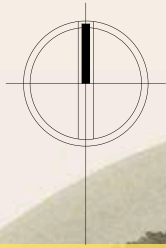

### HOW TO REACH PADUA BOTANICAL GARDEN

**By Plane:** Venice Marco Polo airport (VCE) is about 40 km far from Padua (Padova in Italian) – the city centre can be easily reached by taxi or public transport

**By Train:** The railway station is close to the city centre. You can get to the Botanical Garden by bus or tram (leaving every 10 minutes from the railway station – stop n. 12-Santo)

**By Car:** There are parking facilities surrounding Prato della Valle.

### ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

#### Instructions:

- The Abstract Submission is possible only after Registration.
- Deadline for abstract submission **has been extended until 25th June 2025**.
- Abstracts will be evaluated by the International Scientific Committee and decisions will be emailed to the presenting authors.
- Abstracts will be selected as:
  - **Golden oral presentations** (15 min) to be included in the main program;
  - **Oral communications** (10 min) to be included in the "Oral communications" session;
  - **Posters**, to be displayed during the workshop and discussed during the lunch breaks.
- Abstract submission does not automatically register you for the workshop. If your abstract is accepted, presenting authors must be registered to present at the workshop (**registration new deadline: 25th June 2025**). If you have not registered by that date your abstract will be removed from the workshop programme.
- All accepted abstracts will be published in the program booklet.
- Your abstract will not be edited. You are responsible for any spelling, grammatical and typographical errors
- Only one abstract per presenting author.
- During submission you must select one topic.
- Abstracts must be submitted and, if accepted, must be presented in English.
- Graphics or tables cannot be accepted because of production limitations.
- No changes to the abstract are possible after submission.
- Abstract must include the following sections: **Presenting author, Email Address Presenting Author, Title, Authors, Authors' affiliations, Main text:**
  - **Presenting author:** include first name(s) and last name.
  - **Email Address Presenting Author**
  - **Title:** limit of 300 characters, including spaces. Titles should be in lower case, except the first word, abbreviations and countries. Do not use capital letters only and avoid using abbreviations or acronyms.
  - **Authors:** there is no limit to the number of authors, but try to include no more than 10. Authors should be listed as first name(s) initial(s) and last name.
  - **Authors' affiliations:** include department, institution, city and country for all authors identified with superscript numbers.
  - **Presenting author:** include first name(s), last name and email address.
  - **Main text:** limit of 250 words. Ideally, the main text should include the following sections: Background, Aim, Methods, Results, Conclusion, but you can use different section headings as appropriate.
